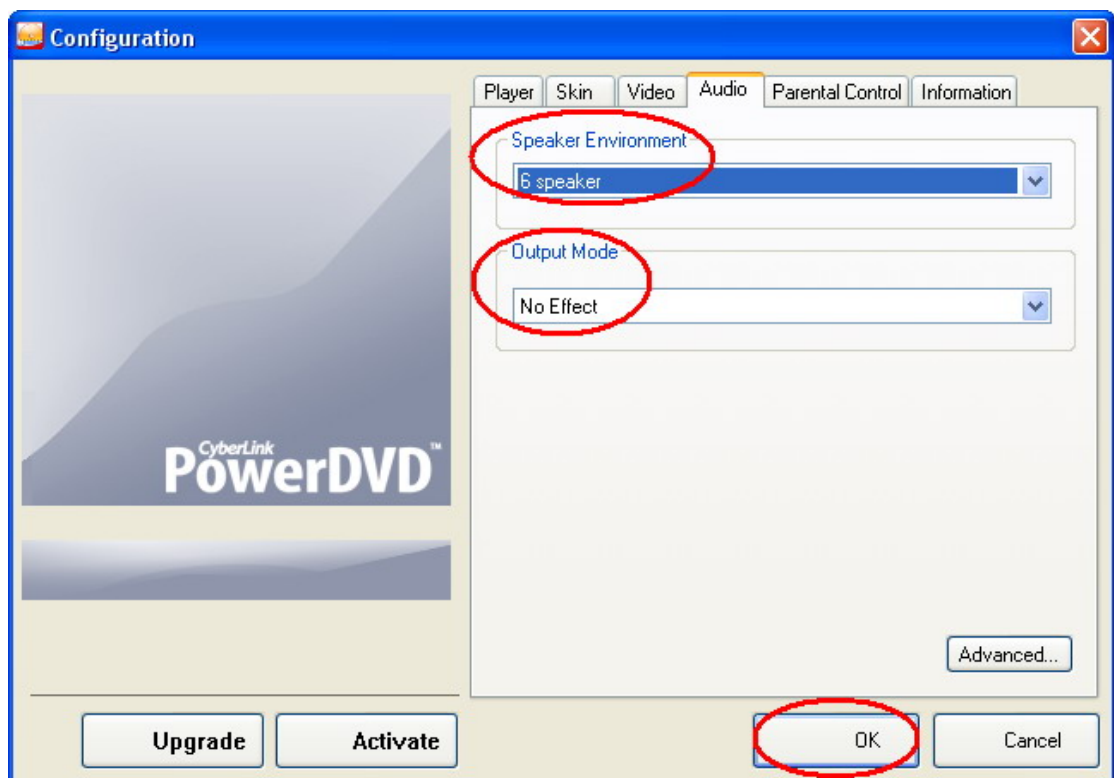


DVD Playback over DH/DVS/DDL/Multiple Analog Speakers

Windows XP

Dolby Headphone (Virtualized 5.1 surround sounds over stereo headphone)

1. Open PowerDVD → Configuration → Audio
2. Select 6 speaker in Speaker Environment
3. Select No Effect in Output Mode
4. Press OK

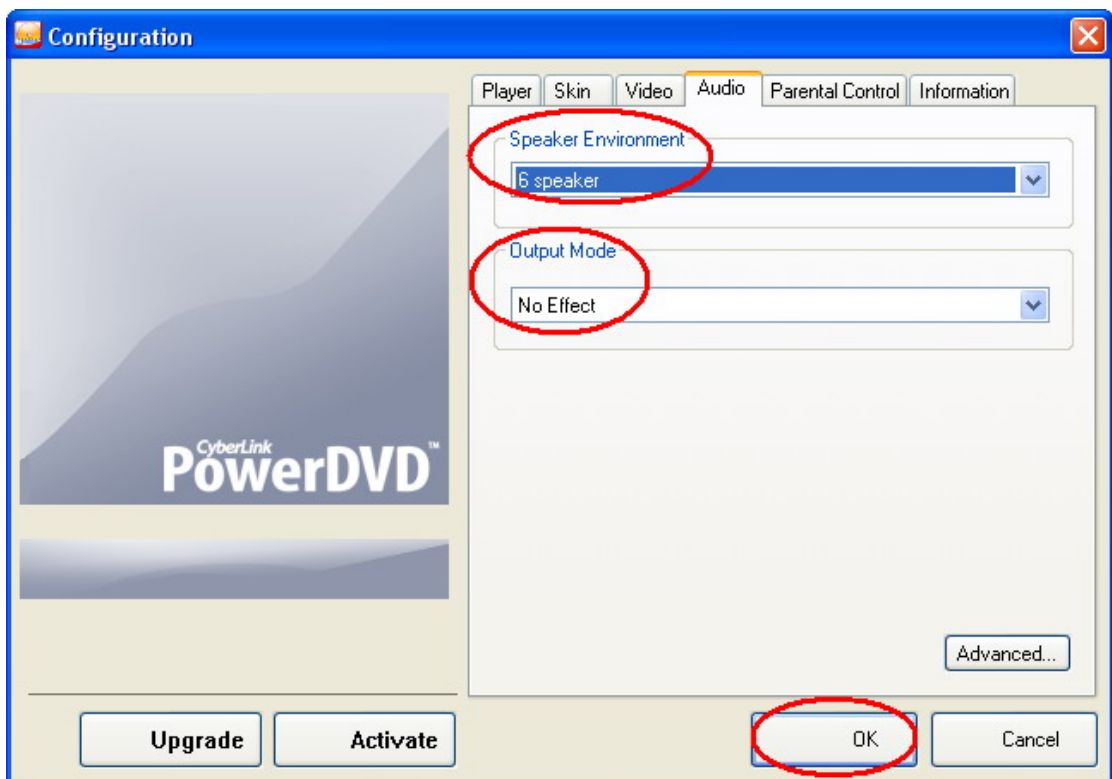


5. Open Xonar Audio Center
6. Select Headphone in Analog Out
7. Check "Dolby Headphone"



Dolby Virtual Speaker (Virtualized 5.1 surround sounds over stereo speakers)

1. Open PowerDVD → Configuration → Audio
2. Select 6 Speaker in Speaker Environment
3. Select No Effect in Output Mode
4. Press OK



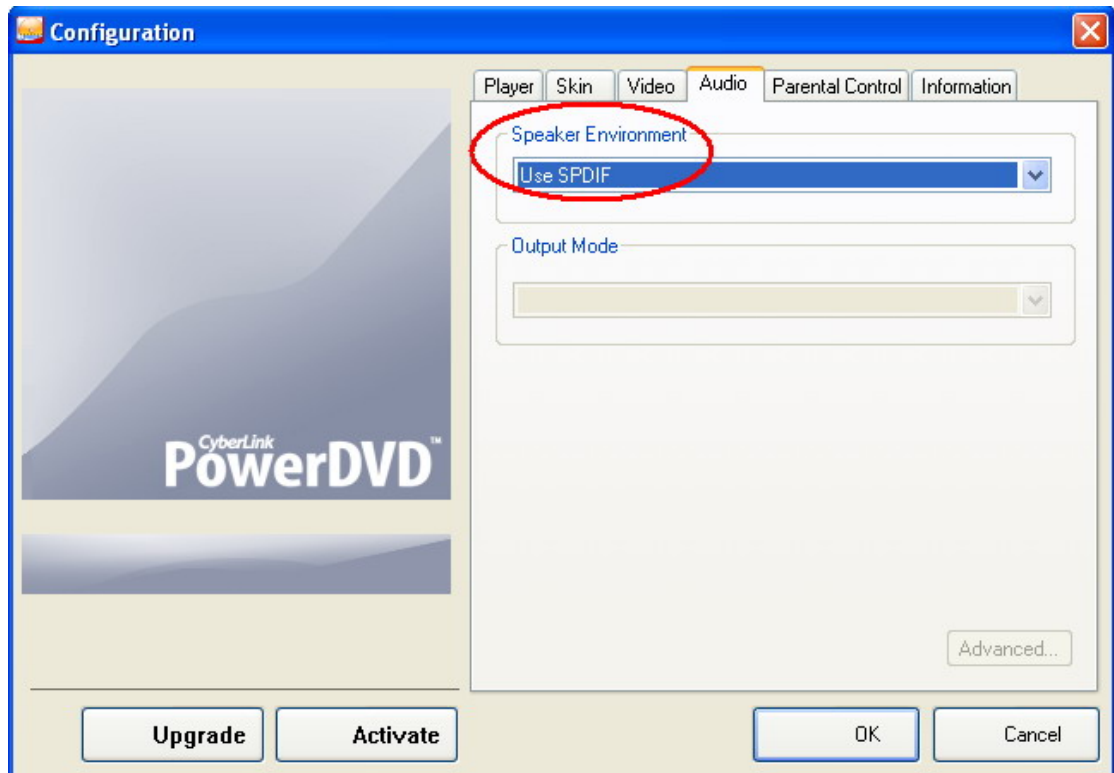
5. Open Xonar Audio Center
6. Select 2 Speakers in Analog Out

7. Check “Dolby Virtual Speaker”



DVD playback by SPDIF (Dolby Digital/DTS digital audio pass-through)

1. Open PowerDVD → Configuration → Audio
2. Select Use SPDIF in Speaker Environment
3. Press OK

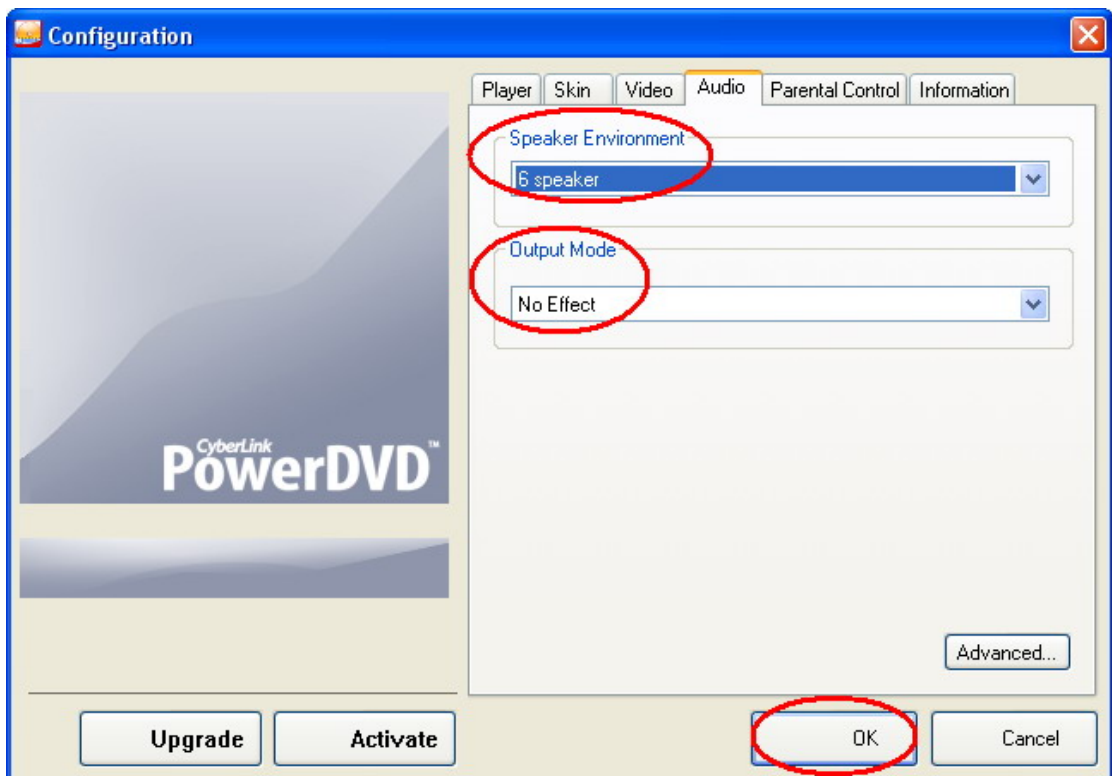


4. Open Xonar Audio Center
5. Enable “SPDIF Out”



DVD playback by SPDIF (Add Sound effects w/ DDL encoding)

1. Open PowerDVD → Configuration → Audio
2. Select 6 speaker in Speaker Environment
3. Select No Effect in Output Mode
4. Press OK



5. Open Xonar Audio Center
6. Enable “SPDIF Out”
7. Select Dolby Digital Live in SPDIF Out

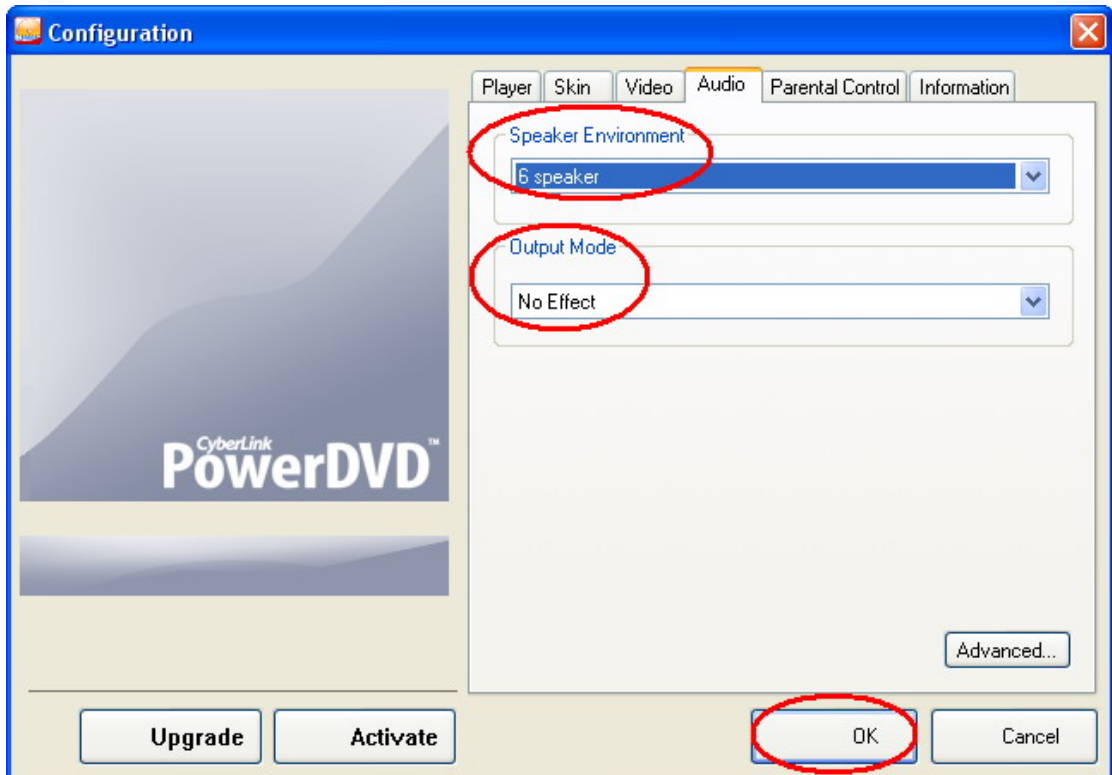

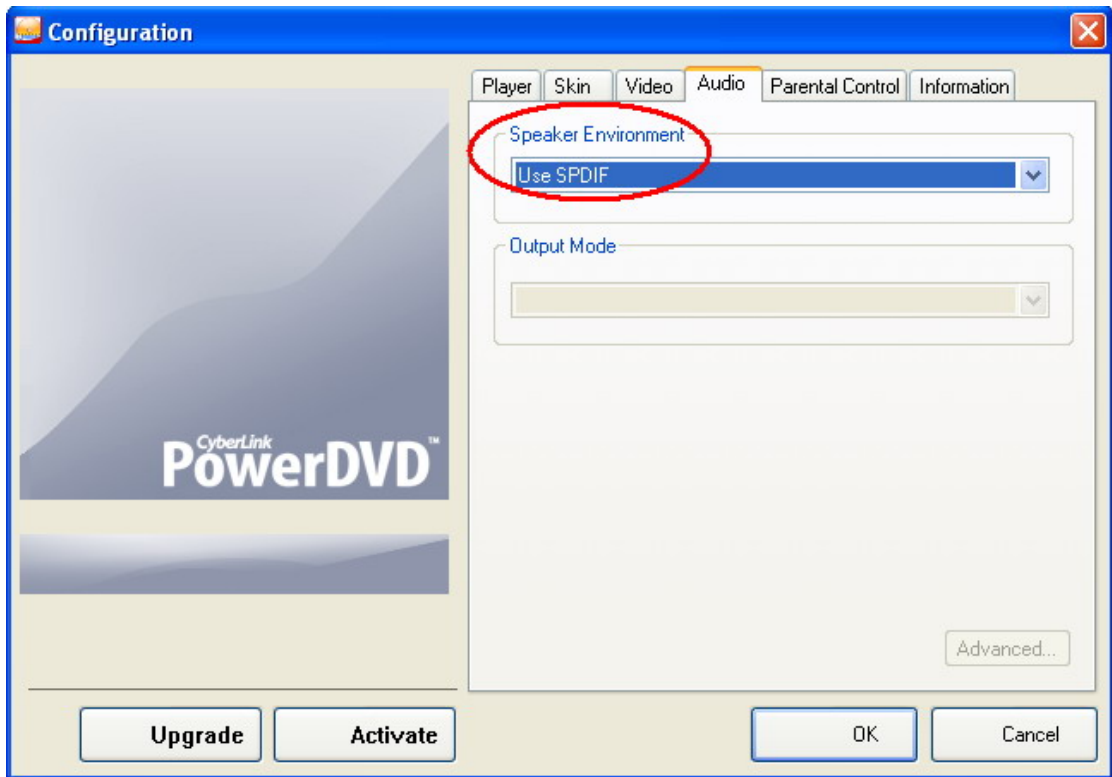
